2. **The College of Internet Distance Education (CIDE).** The Board of Trustees of Assumption University has approved Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman's proposal to establish the College on April 25, 2002 to eventually offer eLearning to 100,000 students per year. The College offers the first and only Ph.D. in eLearning Methodology in the world with applicants from over 30 countries. Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman is the Chairman of the Executive Board and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the College. 3. **Thailand Chapter of the Computer Society of the IEEE.** Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman became a member of the IEEE in 1961. In Thailand, he became the Founder of Thailand Joint Chapter of the Computer Society and the Engineering Management Society of the IEEE. In the year 2008, the Engineering Management Society was renamed, and so, the Joint Chapter was changed to Thailand Chapter of the Computer Society of the IEEE, and Prof. Srisakdi remained the Chairman. Thailand Chapter of the IEEE Computer Society has also been registered with the Registrar in Thailand as Computer Society of the IEEE in Thailand with Prof. Srisakdi in the Position of the Senior President which is an Honorary Position for Life. The President of Thailand Chapter of the Computer Society of the IEEE in the year 2011 is Mr. Pornphisud Mongkhonvanit, the President of Siam Technology College.
4. **Thailand Chapter of the ACM.** Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman became a member of the ACM (Association for Computing Machinery) in 1961. ACM is the largest and oldest Computer Science Learned Society in the world. In the year 1963, Prof. Srisakdi became one of the Founders of the Special Interest Group on University Computer Centers of the ACM. He was also elected Vice President of ACM Rochester Chapter in the USA. In the year 1991, Prof. Srisakdi became the Founder of Thailand Chapter of the ACM. 5. **Thailand Chapter of the Internet Society (ISOC).** The Internet Society (ISOC) was founded in 1991. Prof. Srisakdi proposed to Rev. Bro. Dr. Prathip Martin Komolmas, the President of AU at that time, and got approval for Assumption University of Thailand to be the only Founding Member in South East Asia of ISOC. Prof. Srisakdi became a member of the Advisory Council of ISOC, and elected a member of ISOC Board of Trustees. 6. **Thailand Internet Association.** In the year 1998, in his capacity as the President of Thailand Chapter of ISOC, Prof. Srisakdi established a Committee to draft the first “Internet Promotion Law”. ISOC was against the law by saying that the Internet was free and there should be no law about the Internet. ISOC suspended Prof. Srisakdi from his duties as the President of Thailand Chapter of ISOC. So, he established Thailand Internet Association with about 18,000 members. As of the year 2011, Thailand Internet Association is still strong with over 18,000 members. As of the year 2011, there are all kinds of laws concerning the Internet. 7. **The Association of Thai Internet Industry (ATII).** Prof. Srisakdi was the founder of Internet KSC which was the first and largest ISP (Internet Service Provider) in Thailand. He established ATII on 9 August 2000. More information is available in [www.atii.th.org](http://www.atii.th.org).
8. **Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman Foundation (SC Foundation).** This Foundation was established on 14 July 1998 with Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman as the Chairman. After Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman was named one of twelve members of AIT Inaugural Hall of Fame, he directed SC Foundation to donate one million baht to AIT.
9. **Asia-Pacific eLearning Association.** In the year 2004, the Ministry of Information and Communications Technology appointed Prof. Srisakdi as Chairman of the Organizing Committee of the First International Conference on eLearning for Knowledge-based Society. At the News Conference, the Minister, the Permanent Secretary, and Prof. Srisakdi announced the establishment of Asia Pacific eLearning Association (**eLearningAP**). 10. **The Internet Poll Association.** To support the Internet Poll Research Institute, this legal entity was registered in the year 2011, with Prof. Srisakdi as the President. When Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman was the Founding Chairman of ABAC Poll, he named it ABAC-KSC Internet Poll Research Center and hoped to use the Internet in conducting the surveys. However, ABAC Poll has not used the Internet in conducting survey like Harris Interactive. So, Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman proposed to and got approval from INRIT to establish the Internet Poll Association to support the Internet Poll institute in using the Internet to conduct surveys.
11. **The Association of Thai Federation of Information Processing.** This learned society represents Thailand in International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP). Later, Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman was elected one of the fifteen members of IFIP Board of Trustees. Prof. Srisakdi registered it as “Information Processing Society for National Development” in the year 1982 and it became the only representative of Thailand in IFIP. Later, it was merged to be a part of Thailand Internet Association. Then in the year 2011, it was registered as Association of Thai Federation of Information Processing with Prof. Srisakdi in the Position of the Senior President which is an Honorary Position for Life.
