1. **The Interdisciplinary Network Foundation for Research and Development (INFRD).** INFRD was registered with the Registrar of Foundations in Bangkok on 5 September 2007. 2. **Srisakdi Charmonman Institute of eLearning.** The Board of Trustees of Siam Technology College has approved the establishment of Srisakdi Charmonman Institute of eLearning at the meeting on 3 May 2012. The Institute will become the Center of Excellence in eLearning. The motto of the institute is “Quality eLearning for Anyone, from Anywhere, and at Anytime.” The Institute will offer Ph.D in eLearning Methodology and Ph.D. in Interdisciplinarity with Information and Communications Technology by the end of the year 2012. Four more Ph.D. programs will be offered in the year 2013. Six Master’s Degree Programs with the same fields as the Ph.D. Programs will also be offered in the year 2013. Then, all the other degree programs at Siam Technology College will eventually be offered in the eLearning mode. Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman is the Founder, Chairman of the Board, and Chief Executive Officer of the Institute.
3. **Thailand Chapter of the Computer Society of the IEEE.** Prof. Srisakdi Charmonman became a member of the IEEE in 1961. In Thailand, he became the Founder of Thailand Joint Chapter of the Computer Society and the Engineering Management Society of the IEEE. In the year 2008, the Engineering Management Society was renamed, and so, the Joint Chapter was changed to Thailand Chapter of the Computer Society of the IEEE, and Prof. Srisakdi remains the Chairman. Thailand Chapter of the IEEE Computer Society has also been registered with the Registrar in Thailand as Computer Society of the IEEE in Thailand with Prof. Srisakdi in the Position of the Senior President which is an Honorary Position for Life.
4. **Thailand Chapter of the ACM.** Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman became a member of the ACM (Association for Computing Machinery) in 1961. ACM is the largest and oldest Computer Science Learned Society in the world. In the year 1963, Prof. Srisakdi became one of the Founders of the Special Interest Group on University Computer Centers of the ACM. He was also elected Vice President of ACM Rochester Chapter. 5. **Thailand Chapter of the Internet Society (ISOC).** The Internet Society (ISOC) was founded in 1991. Prof. Srisakdi proposed to Rev. Bro. Dr. Prathip Martin Komolmas, the President of AU at that time, and got approval for Assumption University of

Thailand to be the only Founding Member in South East Asia of ISOC. Prof. Srisakdi became a member of the Advisory Council of ISOC, and elected a member of ISOC Board of Trustees. 6. **Thailand Internet Association.** In the year 1998, in his capacity as the President of Thailand Chapter of ISOC, Prof. Srisakdi established a Committee to draft the first “Internet Promotion Law”. ISOC was against the law by saying that the Internet was free and there should be no law about the Internet. ISOC suspended Prof. Srisakdi from his duties as the President of Thailand Chapter of ISOC. So, he established Thailand Internet Association with about 18,000 members. As of the year 2011, Thailand Internet Association is still strong with over 18,000 members. As of the year 2011, there are all kinds of laws the Internet. 7. **The Association of Thai Internet Industry (ATII).** Prof. Srisakdi was the founder of Internet KSC which was the first and largest ISP (Internet Service Provider) in Thailand. 8. **Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman Foundation (SC Foundation).** This Foundation was established on 14 July 1998 with Prof. Dr. Srisakdi Charmonman as the Chairman.
